Thom Rainer, a well-known Christian blogger and researcher, recently polled over 300 non-churched people, and found that 96% of them are, at least somewhat, likely to attend church if invited! That's an astounding statistic as the translation is that 9 out of 10 would at least consider attending if someone would take the time to invite them. That's where we come in! If you think about the times you have "thought about" inviting someone to attend church, and just put it out of your mind quickly as too difficult, this statistic brings us back to reality... an exciting reality!
